India's Balasarasvati who has danced by invitation before enthusiastic audiences in most of the world's capitols will inaugurate opening of the first summer school in Indian studies of The American Society for Eastern Arts Saturday evening, July 10 in Lisser Hall on the Mills College campus in Oakland, California, when she and her troupe are seen in a classical Bharata Natyam concert.

Co-starring with Bala on the ASEA summer faculty is the well-known Indian virtuoso of the sarode, Ustad Ali Akbar Khan, whose first public performance in the Bay Area will be Saturday, July 17 in the San Francisco Masonic Auditorium. The two artists and their seven accompanying musicians will conduct classes daily in an intensified program of group and private instruction in music and musical instruments of North and South India, and in the disciplines of Indian dance. Each Monday evening during the school the president and the vice-president of the ASEA, Mr. and Mrs. Samuel H. Scripps, founders of the non-profit society, will open their home in Lafayette to students and faculty for an informal pool-side barbecue.

The artists will be seen Sunday afternoons at 4:30 between July 11 and August 29 in a series of lecture-demonstrations which are open to the public at the school. Following final concerts in September, Balasarasvati and Ali Akbar Khan will go on an ASEA sponsored tour of selected institutions throughout the United States.
